The Council has decided to adopt the following Regulation under Article 29(2) of the Treaty on European Union:

Regulation on the protection of personal data in the field of justice and law enforcement, and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC.

This Regulation is adopted in accordance with Article 29(2) of the Treaty on European Union.
