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The grant recipient, the contractor, or recipient is required to manage contracts for their use to ensure that it does not interfere directly or indirectly with the contractor's other job efforts. It should be the duty of the grant recipient to provide adequate information, either orally or in writing, within reasonable effort for the recipient's use. Grant use is prohibited except as by the contractor.

There are two approaches to determining which to implement and whether to implement the technology. The first approach is to determine the relative benefits of the two technologies and then choose the one with the higher benefits. The second approach is to determine the relative costs of the two technologies and then choose the one with the lower costs. The first approach is more difficult because it requires a comparison of the benefits of the two technologies, which is often difficult to do. The second approach is easier because it only requires a comparison of the costs of the two technologies, which is often easier to do.

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
