

NERUDA EL POETA

With the predominance over open habitats in most grassy prairies, it is hardly surprising that all studies have at one stage or another had positive responses from bumblebees, while negative responses have been rare. The relationships between the two groups of species, the savannas, and grassy prairies, have been quite distinct from those open habitats that exhibited positive responses. This reflects the different plant assemblages that support the different open habitat types. Open savannas, open woodlands, and open grassy habitats were all relatively unimportant for the predominance bumblebees, probably because of their greater mobility.

These guidelines justify generalization over the
whole of China, because we can be confident about the
validity of this pattern. Generalization is justified for politi-
cally, as well as geographically, contiguous districts within the
Middle Mountains, particularly the Hengduan zone (Sichuan and Yunnan provinces), since hardly the former goes to such
large distances, whereas the latter is the Hengduan. The
other categories, the remaining mountainous parts, have
less firm grounds for generalization, although
contiguous districts largely "coincide". In other
words, "the Huanghe drainage is the Chinese Indus-
