However, it is important to note that the results presented here are preliminary and need to be confirmed by larger-scale studies. In addition, the results suggest that the use of a single measure of social support may not be sufficient to capture the complexity of social support in the workplace. Future research should explore the use of multiple measures of social support to better understand its role in the workplace.
