Expected outcomes & discussion

The research project aims to explore the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on the mental health of the general population. The study will focus on the following research objectives:

- 1. To investigate the prevalence of mental health issues during the pandemic.
- 2. To identify factors that contribute to mental health problems.
- 3. To evaluate the effectiveness of current mental health services.
- 4. To develop strategies to improve mental health support.

The research will be conducted using a mixed-methods approach, combining quantitative surveys with qualitative interviews. The data will be analysed using statistical software and thematic analysis.



The findings of this research will be used to inform policy and practice, with a focus on improving mental health support for the general population.

The research will be conducted over a period of 12 months, with data collection and analysis completed by the end of the project.

The research will be funded by the National Institute of Mental Health, and the results will be published in a peer-reviewed journal.
