I do not know how many loads  
of Shale have for half a year for the purpose  
of sending up all the articles & provisions  
necessary for my mining Campaign, which are  
making enough calculation in loading the  
Two miners & others that I have engaged to  
Tut & carry things in full effect, when it  
is on the spot or at the mines, will cost me  
at least \$500 - which has been nearly all paid  
You wish to see you & yours are as much content  
in the result of the uncertainty as I am my  
Self, you must endeavor to assist me in that  
is in your power - at present to helping  
the future Expenses as much as possible -  
which you can do with no inconvenience  
Do you Self in many respects  
Therefore you will send up to Santa by the  
third or fourth of the next month my old horse  
one good saddle mule & one good mule & perhaps  
Camp tent for carrying things to & from <sup>the mine</sup> with
