In writing you this letter I am confident you agree that faith and determination are essential in building a strong foundation for the continuous growth and development of the United Nations, thereby obtaining unity and peace among the nations of the world.

One way that will assist the United Nations in these purposes is to adopt one and the same calendar for the use of our one World--The World Calendar.

The World Calendar is a community of time within which the various time-periods (day, week, month, season and year) function in perfect harmony and agreement, irrespective of individual differences. The proposed date for its actual operation is Sunday 1 January 1950, when both the present Gregorian and The World Calendars meet.

Similarly, our world is a community of nations, all nations working and striving together for a better and more peaceful world, regardless of national differences.

We respectfully ask that you read the brief folder, "PEACE--The United Nations and The World Calendar," and, should you be in agreement with it, to give The World Calendar your active support.
