They wish the cooperating schools to be as non-politically controlled as possible, flexible in programs, with a strong educator at the end, and with a sufficiently influential standing among other schools of the country so that it may become a demonstration center.

Would you be so kind as to send me the name and address of the schools in your country which you feel would be most willing to work in this fashion with an American school?
