An All-Australia "Win the Peace" Conference of Women will be held in Sydney, Australia, from the 6th to 11th August, 1946. We have just received approval from the Commonwealth Government to invite overseas visitors.

At this Conference it is hoped International visitors will contribute to the discussion on our theme "No peace without unity and no justice without equality".

Reports will be submitted on :-

- (1) Aspects of the San Francisco Conference.
- (2) The Women's International Democratic Federation Conference in Paris.
- (3) The All-India Women's Conference at Hyderabad.
- (4) Amendment to the Australian Women's Charter.

Addresses will be given by prominent speakers in the Professional, Social, and Industrial life of Australia.

We have great pleasure in inviting you to this Conference. We also invite you to take part in the programme, and, if possible, address public meetings in other State cities, after Sydney meetings are over.

Hospitality will be provided during the Conference and during lecture tours to other States.

When replying to this invitation please let us know whether you will be available to visit other State cities.

We are eagerly looking forward to welcoming women from overseas.

The victory in World War No. 2 has shown us that world peace and security depend on International Co-operation. The understanding and friendship engendered at International Conferences can make active co-operation a reality.

We would be grateful for as early a reply as possible to enable us to make arrangements for accommodation.
