Dear Sir and Respected Colleague:

The affair of Mrs. Kuslin's coat which I was unable to understand was as follows:

I gave the Chilean Embassy in Washington the coat ready to send to the Swedish Embassy. It was lost and forgotten, and Mrs. Kuslin, whom I respect and love, was without her coat for four months. At last the Embassy found the package after my complaints, and about a month ago it was delivered to the Swedish Embassy in Washington.

I hope to be advised in what condition it arrived, in order to know whether or not to look for an equivalent coat for her in Los Angeles or San Francisco. I assume Mrs. Kuslin is in Sweden, as the Swedish Embassy in Washington sent it to Stockholm rather than to Rio de Janeiro.

This affair has been most distressing to me, although it was not my behavior but the stupidity of the Chilean Embassy in Washington that caused the complication in such an elementary affair....
