Dear Pancho:

I liked the article you wrote about Gabriela so very much. The reason I haven't written you sooner is that I've been waiting for the other pieces to come in - the article by Margaret Bates, my own Translator's Note, and four prefatory notes which I wrote to appear before each separate chapter. All these, as you know, had to be co-ordinated. In other words, none of them could overlap to any extent.

The way it works now is that your piece comes first as a Foreword concentrating on the background of literary history. You are followed by Bates' piece and then by my few pages of notes and acknowledgements.

The entire picture is very effective and I am sure you will be pleased with it. It did necessitate cutting your article a bit in order to avoid repetition or overlapping. But that, too, I think worked out well, because the very interesting part you wrote about "mysticism" can be used, if you will agree, to its use, as a preface to another book we are planning re. Gabriela's religious thought.
