My very dear Friend:

I have just read the announcement in the press that you have received the Nobel Prize for Literature. What wonderful news this is! All your friends here are rejoicing that this great and well merited honor has come to you.

A few minutes ago I talked with Dr. De Alba on the telephone and he said it was an honor for the Americas and I replied, "It is also an honor for Women." So you see how we are all trying to share in your glory.

I think many times of the beautiful speech you made for the Mandate Committee when you were last in Washington and I have read it many times in these intervening years. Now I want you to come and speak again! In February we are having a most important Conference of our Committee and we would regard it as the highlight of this gathering if you would speak at a large evening meeting. I told Dr. De Alba that I was sending this invitation to you and he thinks it is a wonderful idea.

The dates of the Conference are not definitely fixed. We think about the middle of February will be best, but you can set the date most convenient for you and we will make our plans to agree.

Will you please send a word to me soon and I hope more than I can tell you that you will say you will come.
