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Dear Doris:

Many thanks for your two letters of March 3rd. I tried to get in touch with you by phone but couldn't.

I agree with you completely and I'm not disappointed but glad because I think it would be much better to publish those variant notes as a separate. It won't be difficult here for me to get the money. I will arrange it directly with Aguilar or some other publisher in Spain. I will re-write that first page and send you a copy. Under the circumstances I will refer specifically to the notes and nothing else. You should receive these in a few days. Right now I'm under the weather and have to go easy.

I called Joan Daves this morning and asked her to write to Aguilar to hold those notes until they hear from me. In a few days I will contact them. The cost shouldn't be too high because they can use very small print.

I consider this an excellent solution because it means avoiding all the proof reading that subsequent editions will entail. These notes will be based on the second edition.

Nobody has seen the two sheets of introductory notes that you objected too. You will be hearing from me soon.
