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Dearest Doris,

Enclosed as a photostat of a letter from DILIA, making a publication offer for a Czech edition of Selected Poetry by Gabriela Mistral. We have dealt with those people before; the terms are in line, I suppose; there is no use saying "NO" anyway,-- because who can control their publications, and who could sue them if they published without official authorization.

However, please look at the attached listing of the poems which they want to use. Does it contain versions of poems you do not wish to have published? How did they get hold of "Poemas Ineditos"-- or does that not mean that they have not ever been published? I think you should do the following, dear:

Send them a short cable of approval, if all is ok. Cable address on their letter head.
If you wish to delete certain poems, write them and specify exactly which ones you want to have scrapped.
AND send us a carbon of your letter so that we can follow up on this.

If all is approved, let me know and I shall send them a contract.
