Dear Miss de Cáceres,

Your letter of February 23 has just come in and I hasten to alleviate your worries by telling you that your Prologue to the third edition of Aguilar's collection of Gabriela Mistral's poems has now been sent to Madrid. The primary reason for the delay in making it available to the Spanish publishers was that we did not wish to send them any material before the contractual arrangements were completed. The contracts have finally been signed and Aguilar can now proceed with their new edition.

Doris has been away quite a while as she undoubtedly will tell you. She has recently returned from CHILE and I handed her your letter although she already had received your direct message. Her address is Box 284, RFD 2, Pound Ridge, N.Y. However, I feel sure that you will be hearing from her quite soon.

I am sorry indeed that my Spanish is not good enough to really understand your Prologue: Doris tells me it is such a fine and sensitive piece of writing.
