Dear Dr. Goldfarb:

I hope that the lengthy delay in paying this bill has not inconvenienced you too much. The Will was probated in Mineola only recently. The check enclosed is for \$235. The difference between your two bills (one for \$160. and one for \$235.) was paid within the last few days by the Chilean Consulate. I insisted on their paying this extra \$75. because of the great inconvenience that they caused you and the extra trips you took to the hospital on their account. Thank you for keeping the bills so low; they were in no way proportionate to the efforts you made on behalf of Gabriela.

For my part, I want to thank you with all my heart for all the care and attention you gave to Gabriela in those last terrible months. I thank you also for your great kindness to me. It has been a great comfort to me to know how deeply confident Gabriela felt in your care, and that to the very end she was aware of how well you fought the fight.

I hope that I shall see you again, and that I may thank you personally for all your kindness. Perhaps sometime when I come out to Roslyn I might be able to see you if it were not an inconvenience for you. Thank you again for your patience in waiting for this payment.
