



—the existing political, economic and social conditions, leading to the introduction of a political system, based on the principle of universal suffrage, free periodic elections and the separation of powers; to prepare a law on the right to vote publicly, permit the general use of written ballots; and to ensure a free press, control the sale of alcohol. His mandate, however, stipulated that he should also investigate the conditions of the country and report on them to the National Assembly.

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
