My dear Father

I have been on the ship "Patriot" with every thing necessary for operation at the mine with the exception of animal traps. I hope that you will not forget my message, as I shall leave this for the threshold on your tomb.

There has been a few days ago another Rich with disease in low down in the Labrador allowed to be much wider a Rich than any of the former shown him at the Government office when the discoverer came to take out his payments. I was fortunate enough to take out one for you & my self. It is perhaps yet the bones of the tooth may yet be some probability to see the my mother's Patria has been.

By the way Father your great-grandson is now in the 10<sup>th</sup> in ady in state & soon another noble Patriot will be a hero with the sea.
